

Kythira Web Design Terms and Conditions

1. Quotes are valid for 28 days.
2. It is the customer's responsibility to ensure that any web site is lawful, does not infringe any copyright or any other laws.
3. We reserve the right to refuse to construct a web site that we may judge as unfit due to content or otherwise. This includes, but is not limited by, sites containing adult oriented material such as pornography, sites which promote hatred towards persons belonging to any ethnic group, religion or sexual orientation and sites which infringe copyright or are contrary to UK laws.
4. The acceptance of a commission quote either verbally or in writing shall be deemed as a contractual agreement between the client and Kythira Web Design.
5. At project acceptance Kythira Web Design can provide an estimated completion date, however we cannot guarantee this date as a final completion date.
6. A deposit of no less than 50% of the total quoted price must be provided before project commencement, unless otherwise agreed with Kythira Web Design.
7. Once a commission has commenced it will be completed using the information, data, text and images provided at project commencement or during the design phase. Once the design process has been completed the project will be presented to the client who may request changes to design and content.
8. Kythira Web Design will upload the client's web site in order that the client may view and comment upon the project. Once the client has approved the project a final invoice will be issued.
9. By approving the project the client is agreeing that the design and development of the site has satisfied all their requirements.
10. The invoice must be paid within 28 days. Kythira Web Design reserve the right to remove the site at any time until the invoice is paid in full.
11. Kythira Web Design reserve the right to alter our prices at any time without prior notice. If a quote at an original price has been made it will be valid for 28 days and subsequently during the life of the current commission, however additional work may be charged for using the new pricing structure.
12. All material, both text and images, supplied by the client and used in the construction of the client's web site, will remain the client's property. All such material will be assumed to be the property of the client and free to use without fear of breach of copyright laws.
13. Kythira Web Design produce projects where every effort is made to display the pages acceptably on most popular browsers currently available, however we cannot accept responsibility for pages which don't display properly on versions of browsers released after the project is completed.
14. A client wishing to update their own content must request this facility *before* development work commences on the website. The cost of the editing software, enablement and instruction, plus installation on the client's computer (if required) will be quoted for.
15. The client should be aware that it will only be possible to access specified editable regions within the web site. The editing software has limited functionality and set styles.
16. The web site master template will not be uploaded to the hosting server, and will therefore not be available to the client or any other party to access directly.
17. Once the project has been approved and hosted and the invoice issued any updating or subsequent work requested by the client will be charged at the published hourly rate.
